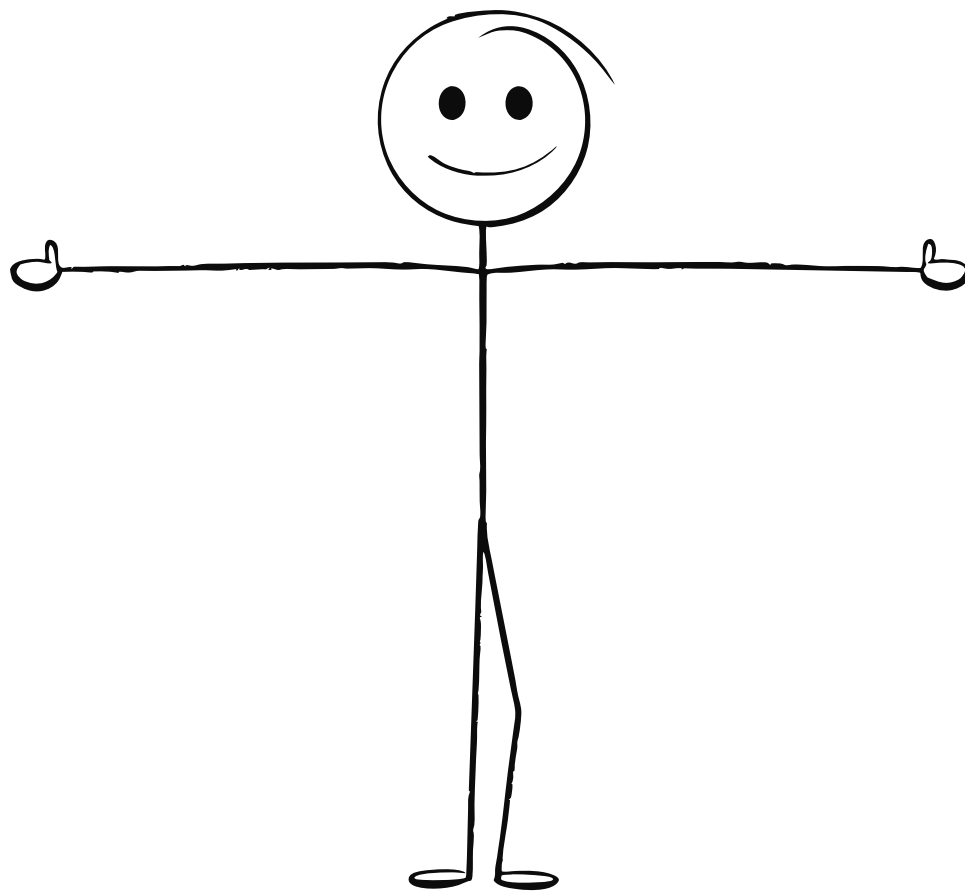




# Things to **know** about 'green' genes...

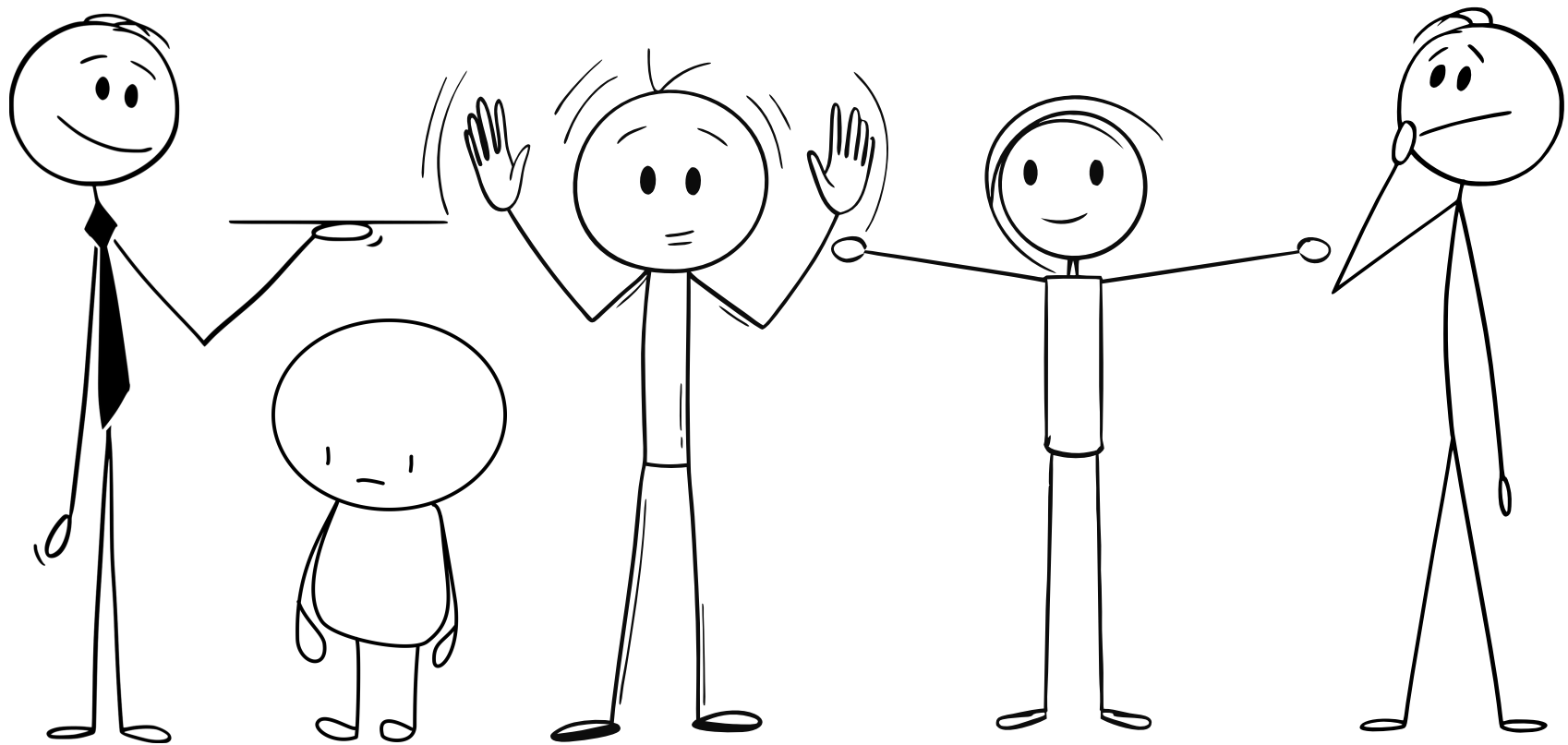




# they still need some love
